In accordance with Section B of Article VII of the Pimmit Hills Citizens Association Constitution, as amended, set forth below are proposed amendments to be voted on at the October 6, 1953 meeting.

Proposed amendment to Article VI Sections c and d:

"The District Representatives shall be appointed by the Executive Committee to serve for a period of one year. Term of office shall coincide with the term of office for the elected officers of the Association. Said District Representatives to be chosen, one from each district recognized by the Association as an official district. The Executive Committee will announce newly appointed District Representatives at the regular July meeting of the Association."

Proposed amendment to Section 2 a of the By-laws:

(a) "The regular meetings shall be held on the first Tuesday of the month!"
